Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme (DofE) at Cathkin High School – A parent-led partnership

Fun, Learning New Skills, Volunteering in the Community and Exploring the Outdoors; all these activities give our kids non-academic but really valuable life skills. The PC has helped develop and run the first DofE awards centre at Cathkin High School. We have 20 (S3) pupils working towards their Bronze Award.
